Part 1 of 2

Focus: How we can conduct ourselves worthy of the gospel of Jesus.

1. We must display that we are citizens of heaven (v. 27).

2. We must be unified in the advancement of the gospel (v. 27).

4. Share some ways that you have sought to advance the gospel of Christ, which is really an advancement of the fame and honor and worth of Jesus Christ. Is the value of gospel advancement high or low in your life? What do you think may be holding you back? Do you see how you can apply the gospel to all aspects of life? What does it mean to be gospel-centered as a Sunday School teacher, a businessman or woman, an employee, a boss, an athlete, a musician, an artist, and so forth? Pick one and share.
