

“Worshipping From A Cave”

Psalm 57

FOCUS: How to display the greatness and worth of God in the midst of your troubles.

1. Pray to God from the back of the cave (Vv. 1-3).

You must cry out to God recognizing your utter dependency (v. 1).

You must see God as your only and great hope (v. 2).

You must anticipate future grace (v. 3).

2. Praise God from the back of the cave (v. 5, 7-11).

You must resolve to trust God in the midst of trouble (v. 7).

You must resolve to spread God's fame (Vv. 5, 8-11).

Discussion Questions

1. Trials, difficulties, tragedies, etc. are part of the human experience. How has your outlook on these things changed since becoming a Christian? What difference has it made in your life? Share.
2. If you have been a Christian for a while, you know the ideal of how you should walk through trials. As you look at your life, how do you functionally go through your difficulties? Do you find yourself more often than not going through it God's way? Talk about it.
3. How important has Scripture memorization been to you? How does/has Scripture memory helped you in cave? Is there a passage or verse that you can commit to memory? Talk about.
4. If you could take away one thing from this message, what would it be and why? Share.
